- c. Give 24-Hour Notice to Solid Waste Supervisor Prior to Material Deliveries
- d. Do Not Disturb Existing Wetlands

VII. Questions

- 1. Where will the sand stockpile be located?
 - a. The sand stockpile will be located east of the excess stockpile shown on drawing 2.
- 2. Can the contractor staging area be moved out of low spot?
 - a. Yes, the staging area will be moved north of current staging area shown on the drawings.
- 3. Is the quantity shown on line item 2 "Excavate Soil to Subgrade Elevations" accurate?
 - a. Minimal grading has occurred within the limits of proposed construction since the last aerial. There is an aerial schedule to occur prior to construction. We believe there will be less than a 5,000 CY of change from the original provided quantity.
- 4. What does line Item 13 Provide & Install Temporary Rain Flap Berm on the bid form include?
 - a. Line Item 13 includes the berms specified as shown in Sacrificial Rain Flap in Detail F & Temporary Rain Flap- Detail I.

- b. Cost to construct Detail H Temporary Liner Termination Berm should be included in Line 14 of the bid tab.
- 5. Do the stair steps need to be cut out before placing clay?
 - a. The contractor should plan on cutting out the stair steps during subgrade excavation along Phases I, II, and III so these locations can be surveyed as KDHE has required this at other facilities.
- 6. Will there be a charge for overruns on the sand?
 - a. The County will provide sufficient sand to construct Phase IV protective/drainage layer and berms as depicted in the Construction Drawings. Use of sand beyond those depicted in the construction drawing will be the responsibility of the Contractor.
- 7. When can construction start?
 - a. Construction can commence once the County selects a Contractor and proper paper work is filed, the soonest to start would be estimated at mid to late March.
- 8. Are SWPPP's required.
 - a. SCS Engineers will not be reviewing the SWPPP's but all local, state and federal regulations should be followed by the contractor.
- 9. Can the contractor pay the surveyor for additional trips to do construction surveying?
 - a. Additional trips for certification surveying due to deficient work or Contractor's request will be at the Contractor's sole expense.
- 10. How much notification time does the surveyor require?
 - a. Contractor must provide written notice at least 7 days prior to needing Surveyor on-site.
- 11. Can the AutoCAD file be provided for quantity estimating purposes?
 - a. The AutoCAD file for the Phase IV construction can be obtained by completing the attached Electronic Release Agreement and submitting to <u>bclements@scsengineers.com</u>

VIII. Modification to Project Manual dated January 2020

- 1. The Contract time to reach Substantial Completion will be increased from 60 calendar days to 90 calendar days. The time to reach Final Completion after Substantial Completion will remain at 30 calendar days. In addition, the Work Completion date of October 31, 2020 is not being extended.
- 2. The County will supply the sand necessary to construct the proposed berms shown in Details F, H, and I.

Neither this Agreement nor the license hereby granted may be transferred, sold or assigned.
- 5. If SCS's name, title block and/or logo appear in the Electronic Files, RECIPIENT agrees to delete same prior to using the Electronic Files.
- 6. SCS makes no representation or warranty as to the compatibility of the Electronic Files with RECIPIENT's hardware or software, or that the means or media of electronic transfer of the Electronic Files is free of computer virus.
- 7. RECIPIENT is aware that differences may exist between the Electronic Files delivered and the data or hard copy files from which the Electronic Files are derived. It shall be RECIPIENT's responsibility to determine the accuracy, correctness and completeness of the information contained in the Electronic Files and whether any conflicts exist with other data or records.
- 8. RECIPIENT acknowledges that the Electronic Files have not been prepared for the purposes of determining exact locations of features or dimensions. SCS makes no warranties or guarantees, express or implied, as to the accuracy, correctness or completeness of the information contained in the Electronic Files, including any warranty of merchantability or warranty of fitness for a particular purpose. RECIPIENT agrees to independently verify the accuracy, correctness and completeness of the Electronic Files for its needs. Use of the Electronic Files provided herewith is solely at the risk of the RECIPIENT, and RECIPIENT

covenants not to sue and waives and releases SCS, its officers, directors, employees and subconsultants from and against any claims or liability resulting from such use, whether in tort, contract or otherwise.

- 9. SCS shall have no obligation to notify RECIPIENT of, or to provide to RECIPIENT, any revisions or changes to the data or information contained in the Electronic Files.
- 10. RECIPIENT agrees, to the fullest extent permitted by law, to indemnify, defend and hold harmless SCS, its officers, directors, employees and subconsultants against all claims, damages, liabilities or costs, including reasonable attorneys' fees and defense costs, whether in tort, contract or otherwise, arising from RECIPIENT's use of the Electronic Files. In no event shall SCS be liable for indirect or consequential damages as a result of RECIPIENT's use of the Electronic Files.
- 11. The Uniform Computer Information Transactions Act (UCITA) does not apply to this Agreement.
- 12. This Agreement shall be construed in accordance with the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, without regard to Virginia's choice of law rules. Venue for any dispute arising out of or related to this Agreement shall lie exclusively in the state and federal courts of Fairfax County, Virginia and the parties hereby submit to the jurisdiction of such courts.
- 13. The Agreement constitutes the sole and entire agreement between SCS and RECIPIENT regarding the Electronic Files. This Agreement replaces and supersedes all prior discussions and agreements between RECIPIENT and SCS with respect to the matters contained herein.

By executing this Agreement, the undersigned affirms that he/she is duly authorized to enter into contractual agreements on behalf of RECIPIENT and RECIPIENT agrees to the terms of this Agreement.
