ITEM A. RESOLUTION 2025-10: Appointment of Wendy Prosser as Interim County Appraiser:

-Patrick Hoffman, County Counselor, per Kansas statute, an Appraiser must be appointed for a four-year term every fourth year following July 1, 1997. Wendy Prosser, currently serving as County Appraiser, was first appointed to a term beginning December 1, 2020. At this time, the Commission will consider the appointment of Ms. Prosser as the interim Barton County Appraiser. Due to an issue with required training with the Kansas Department of Revenue, Property Valuation Division, Ms. Prosser's eligibility has changed. It is anticipated that the issue will be resolved within six months and that Ms. Prosser will fulfill the remainder of the term.

ITEM B. COUNTY APPRAISER: Updated Employment Agreement:

-Mr. Hoffman will provide details. With the adoption of a Resolution appointing Ms. Prosser as Appraiser, it is appropriate to consider an employment agreement covering that same term.

ITEM C. REQUEST FOR QUOTE: Media Consultant:

Under the RFQ, the successful vendor(s) will assist Barton County in improving its media outreach, civic engagement and visibility of County services, policies and public engagement opportunities.
